Principal's Report

Dear Parents,

Tonight, Monday 14th August, at 6pm, we are holding our Parent Information Evening for Kindergarten (Prep) 2018. 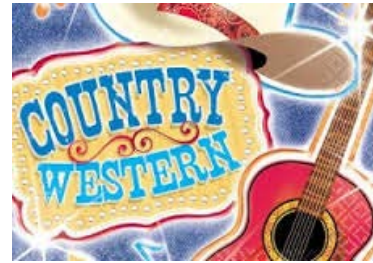
