Principal's Report

Dear Parents,

I hope the Parent Information Sessions last week were beneficial. Please remember that if you have any questions, concerns or are unsure of anything please ask one of our staff members for assistance. It is really important to keep our communication lines open and help out wherever we can.

Congratulations to our school leaders who had their Induction at Assembly on Friday.

The School Swimming Carnival will be held on Monday 19th February at the Cobram Swimming Pool. This is for **all Year 3 to 6 children (and Year 2 children turning 8 in 2018, who can swim 50m)**. Notes went out last week and need to be returned by this Wednesday. If you are able to help out on the day please indicate this on the note.

It is fantastic that the Dental Service has resumed their visits to schools after a number of years. This service is free to all students attending NSW schools, who have returned their permission notes. Even if you have regular dental visits, the experienced staff are able to check your child's teeth for any problems. Please return the permission notes as soon as possible.

If you are having any difficulties making payments for excursions etc., please contact the school prior to the event so a suitable arrangement can be made.

By law, any student enrolled at school, should attend, unless there is a valid reason. If your child is away, a suitable explanation needs to be provided as soon as possible, on their return. If it is a planned absence this can even be done prior to the absence. To assist parents provide a timely reason for any absences, we have included some pre-printed notes, which just need the details filled in. Also included with the newsletter is a technology permission note and a Local Area note.

Emergency Information Cards have also been sent home today. Could you please complete one card per child and return to the office as soon as possible. These cards provide us with important and current information about your child/ren and how to contact you in the event of an accident, injury or illness. It is important that we distribute new cards each year as circumstances change and we require the most up to date information possible. This year the cards have been printed on blue coloured card.

Please remember to notify the school, via a note to their teacher, of any changed arrangements for children travelling home from school. This includes other parents collecting your child, changes to bus travel or going home with another student. This saves confusion during the very busy end of day.
