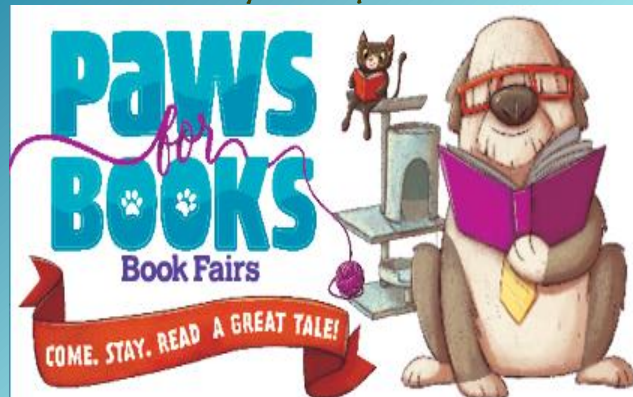
Our next meeting will be **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> August** at 6pm in the library and everyone is welcome.

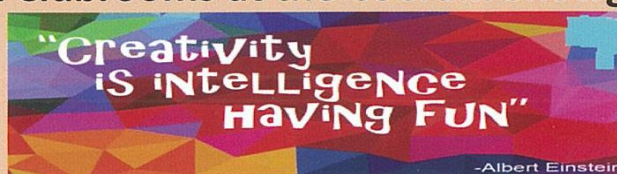
