As this is the last week of term everyone is reminded that the school is enclosed land and you are trespassing unless you have official approval to be on the grounds. Police and Security make regular patrols.

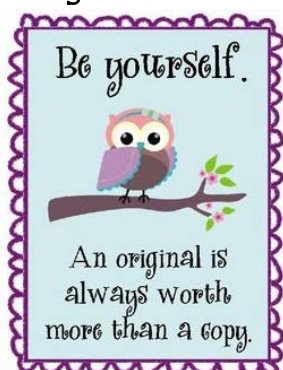
We hope everyone has a happy and safe holiday. Students and staff will return on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> October.
