We had a busy week in our first Kitchen lessons for Years 3-6 last week. Our theme was BPS Café! The children ordered wraps or salads with several choices of fillings. When in groups, some prepared the lunch orders and some made Apricot and Coconut Muffins for all to enjoy.

Our focus in the kitchen this week was knife safety: how to carry knives in the kitchen, how to use knives correctly (ask your child about a 'bear claw' and a bridge grip) as well as washing up procedures. We also discussed hand washing in the kitchen.

I was very impressed with how all classes went with preparing the recipes, being respectful of kitchen rules and safety, and working as a team to prepare and clean up.
