# BOOK FAIR

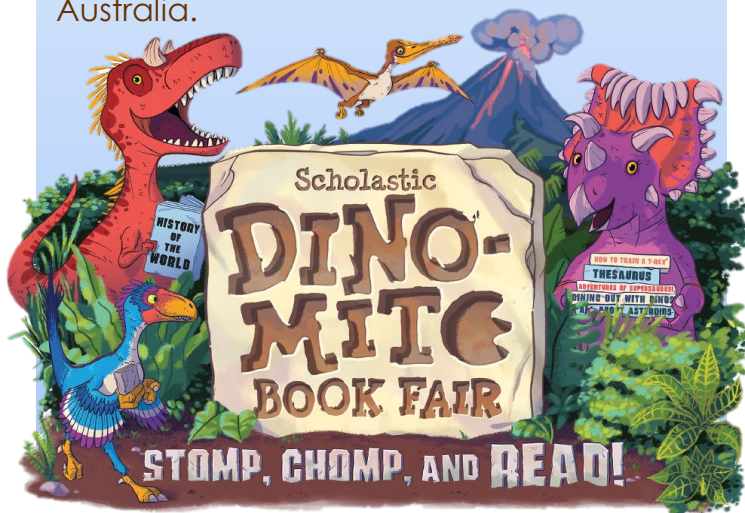
## Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> September

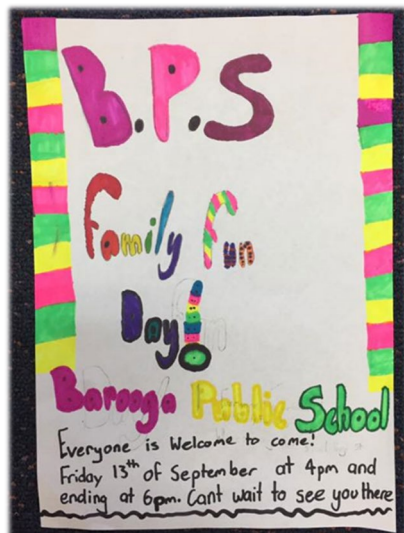
