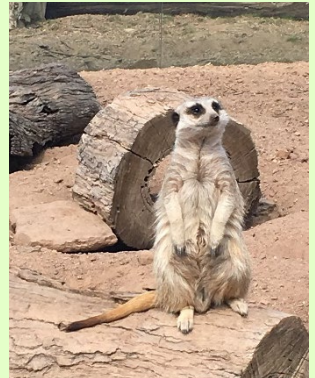
Year 2 Recounts

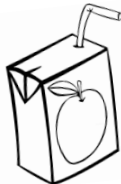
