

Principal's Report

Mr Francis will be on leave for the next three weeks. During this time I will be relieving as Principal. Mrs Morley and Mrs Hyde will be covering my Year 3/4 class.

Uniform: Earlier in the year we purchased new skorts for our Year 6 girls to trial. These are very similar to the current skort but the different fabric makes them hold their shape better and look smarter for our daily uniform. They also come in a larger range of sizes including adult small and medium. The P&C has added these skorts as girls uniform and they can be purchased from Worklocker in Cobram. The current skort can also be worn each day but is more suitable for sports days.

Joffa's Toonschool: Persistence, communication, listening and growth mindset were some of the key messages conveyed in Joffa's ToonSchool workshops today. The students applied lots of skills to participate in the cartoon drawing workshops. Joffa broke down the cartooning into small, manageable chunks and provided instructions in entertaining ways. As you would be aware there have been some easing of restrictions in NSW and this also applies to schools. We are still on Level 3 settings for schools, but with a few modifications. These are outlined below. Just remember that we still need to take care when out and about, this is especially the case with nearby cases and local exposure sites. COVID-19 Advice to Families

- Students must not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19.
- All Parents, carers, staff or visitors to the school must show proof of vaccination and QR check in.
- Parents and carers can come on site if they are supporting curriculum delivery, such as P & C
 Meetings, kitchen, garden, sport etc, or if you have a pre-arranged meeting.
- Continue to drop-off and pick-up outside of the school grounds, maintaining physical distancing of 1.5m, and avoid gathering outside of school gates.
- Parents may be invited to attend outdoor assemblies, but must show proof of vaccination and QR check in, via the office.
- If your child is late to school, please drop them at the gate and send them via the office to collect a late-pass. You can ring the office to let them know the reason for being late.
- Masks are required indoors for adults, including staff






Book Fair
