Principal's Report

Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you to everyone who has returned notes so promptly. We appreciate their speedy return. If you haven't already done so please return them to the office as soon as possible.

Please contact the office if there is a change of routine for your child. This may include catching buses, walking home, being picked up or if you are running late. We can then ensure your child knows how they are getting home.

Next Wednesday 17th February, after school, we are having Class Information Sessions for parents/carers of Years 1 to 6 (Kinder information is organised separately). Notes have been sent home today. Please read carefully and respond if you intend to come, as with so many things happening at present we may have to make adjustments depending on numbers.

Last week we started swimming for our Years 3 to 6 and those in Year 2 who turn eight this year, in preparation for our school Swimming Carnival next week (Friday 19th February) and the Finley Zone PSSA Swimming Carnival the following week.

Last week Years 3 to 6 started in the Garden with a lot of enthusiasm, ripping out weeds which have overtaken the garden in the summer, in preparation for planting. This week we are in the Kitchen, whipping up a storm. Generally non-essential adults, including parents and carers, are not permitted on school grounds, except for the following:

- Attend a pre-arranged meeting with staff
- Volunteering
- P & C meetings outside of school hours
- visitors sign the Visitors' Book and External Visitors Declaration as well as use the QR code.

- **Bring a drink bottle**
- **Stay Away** when sick and get **tested** if you have flu like symptoms
- Encourage good hand hygiene practices and remind your children to cough and sneeze into their elbow.
