Dear Parents, Carers and Supporters of BPS,

I trust the conversations were informative and resulted in co-developed goals for your children. We achieved close to 70% coverage in most classes. This is a promising indicator of the importance which you all place on the education of your child.


Principal's Report

NAPLAN 2023 Results

Students in Year 3 and Year 5 completed NAPLAN assessments in March this year. Individual student reports will be sent home today along with a letter providing a background of the assessments. Although this information relates to only a portion of parents/carers at this point in time, I believe it is in the interest of all families to take note to the following:

- NAPLAN results should be considered together with school-based assessments and reports. Your child's teacher will have the best insight into your child's educational progress.

I strongly believe that our recent Semester 1 meeting processes are your best source of information on how your child is progressing academically combined with our reformed semester report. It is poignant to note that NAPLAN was completed four months ago. As the time has passed, our intervention programs have catered for a number of students with developing skills and knowledge.

Mrs Jones and myself are available to discuss the NAPLAN reporting process and answer any questions you may have.

Kindergarten 2024 Transition Program

We have had an encouraging response from families in our catchment area looking to enrol their child in our transition program. Our 16 week program aims to increase school familiarity and readiness for children beginning Kindergarten in 2024. We are providing fully subsidised transport for children to attend each session as well as transition uniform- check out our shirt! 



Encouraging Positive School Attendance

Regular attendance at school is essential to assist students to maximise their potential. Schools, in partnership with parents, are responsible for promoting the regular attendance of students. In the coming weeks, I will be sharing our school based plan to support and encourage positive school attendance. As a general rule, we strive for **90% of our students attending school 90% of the time**. This key statistic is able to be monitored easily using data platforms available to the school. Here is how we are tracking so far in 2023
