If you have any small jars with lids could you please drop in to the kitchen so the children and volunteers can make jams/lemon butter.

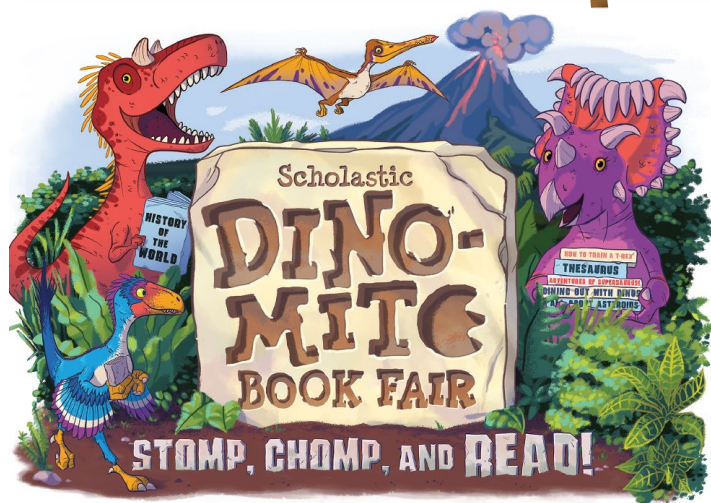
