## Parenting Tips...

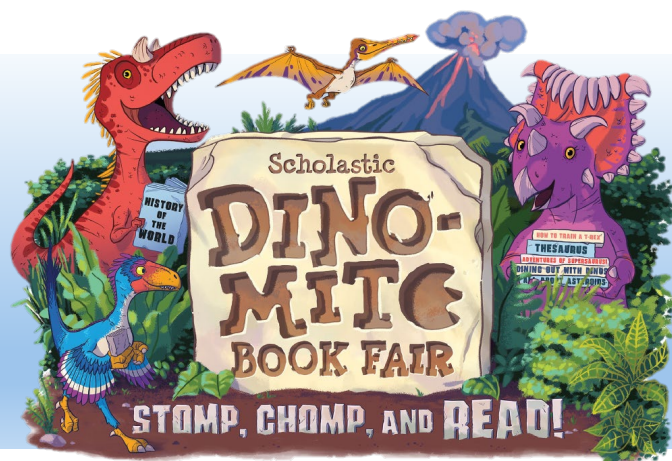
